Treasurer's Report



Area V had a very successful 2021 financially. We had several small fundraising activities, the Team Challenges were fun and profitable, and our Silent Auction in the Fall exceeded our expectations. A huge thank you is due to your council members for all their hard work and to the general membership who supported our programs throughout the year.

The 2021 budgets finished the year as follows:

- Administration budget finished the year \$64.40 in the black
- Adult Rider budget finished \$2,634.01 in the black
- Young Rider budget finished \$6,736.07 in the black

Your 2022 program coordinators are looking forward to fun, educational activities in the coming year that will be a bit more economical for the participants as a result of the positive financial performance from 2021.

USEA & USEF Updates



- EquiRatings Quality Indexes (EQRIs)
 - Each horse registered with the USEA has an ERQI report assigned to them based on its competition history and a comparative analysis of the competition division.
 - You may find the ERQI rating for your horses in the USEA Online Services under the ‘My Related Horses’ tab. Beside each horse’s profile will be the ERQI rating strategically computed for that horse. In addition, prior to each competition, a list of horses who are entered in divisions in which they fall under the amber category are sent to event organizers to be reviewed after the completion of the dressage phase merely as an additional notification tool of horses who may or may not have difficulty competing at the level in which they are entered.
- Microchipping – Proposed requirements
- 2022 EV Rule Changes - Here are a few of the changes for this year, but you can find all of them by visiting the Rulebook on the USEF website
 - Placement poles are not allowed at National Horse Trials
 - Compulsory Retirement (CR) in SJ for 20 or more jump penalties at Training and above. For safety reasons, a competitor who receives a CR at Training level or above will not be given permission to ride the cross-country course.

Young Rider Program



- “Sleep Away Camp” is back!
 - This summer we are bringing back the old-school camp!
 - We will host a 3 or 4-day camp during the month of June for all levels with dressage, SJ and XC lessons taught by certified instructors and will also provide fun activities and educational sessions
 - More details to come
- Emerging Athletes 21 Program (EA21)
 - The USEA will be hosting the EA21 program which will consist of three regional clinics in the summer which will lead to a national camp in the winter. The aim is for the regional clinics to be open to USEA Young Rider program members aged 21 and under, and then selections will be made from the regional clinics and Young Riders will be chosen to attend the national camp in the winter.
 - Clinic locations and application process will be announced later this spring
- 2022 Young Rider Eventing Championship
 - 1*, 2*, 3* levels, ages
 - Tryon International 3-Day will host the 2022 USEF Young Rider Eventing Championship on November 10-13, 2022
 - 2022 USEF Young Rider Eventing Championship Application/Area Declarations are due by May 1, 2022
